GEORGETOWN COMMUNITY SERVICES ASSOCIATION TENNIS COURT RULES

- 1. **Hours of Operation**: Daily from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- 2. **Authorized Users:** The tennis courts are for the exclusive use of property owners and their guest, and the tenants of non-resident property owners and their guest. If a property is more than 30 days past due, no one from that property will be allowed tennis court access until the account balance is fully paid. Violations of rules concerning the use of amenities or common areas may also lead to suspension of tennis court privileges.

3. Operational Guidelines:

- a. Use of the courts will be on a first come, first serve basis.
- b. All guests must be accompanied by a Georgetown resident. The member will be held responsible for the actions of the guest.
- c. All persons using the Association's facilities do so at their own risk. The Association is not responsible for any accidents or injuries in connection with improper utilization of the facilities.
- d. All players should wear appropriate attire. Soft, smooth-soled tennis shoes are mandatory. Shirts must be worn at all times.
- e. When others are waiting to play, court playing time is limited to one (1) hour.
- f. All children under fourteen years old must be supervised.
- g. Pets are not permitted on the tennis courts.
- h. Only playing participants, judges, and referees are permitted on the courts.
- i. Leaning on the nets, striking the top of the net with the racket, or jumping over the net is not permitted.
- j. No food is permitted on the courts.
- k. No smoking/vaping or consuming alcoholic beverages.
- 1. The courts are to be closed for use after 8:00 p.m.
- m. Roller blades, roller skates, skateboards, bicycles, and hockey playing are not permitted on the tennis courts.
- n. The cost of any damage to the court will be charged to the responsible parent or resident.
- o. Causing undue disturbance in or around the facility will not be permitted. Music or other sounds from radios, cell phones, and other devices shall only be listened to via headphones. Cell phone conversations shall be discrete and not bother other tennis court patrons.
- p. Anyone under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be required to leave.
- q. No littering. Please place trash in the receptacles provided.
- r. Management reserves the right to immediately stop any unauthorized activity and may temporarily suspend the use of the facility in accordance with the Georgetown CSA Guidelines.
